Course Description

This training is a condensed version of the Essentials for Healthy Homes Practitioners course for accelerated training for those individuals who already have certification as a professional in a healthy home field of expertise. It complements hazard-specific training in lead-based paint, radon, mold, pests, and asbestos and identifies root causes of health problems in a home and links them to the seven principles of healthy housing. Course participants will have additional understanding of how their current area(s) of expertise can be integrated with the healthy homes principles so they are better prepared to make healthy homes a reality in their

communities.
