**Name of Program:** Home Weatherization Assistance Program**Agency:** Summit County, Department of Development**Description:** No-cost energy assistance program designed to increase the energy efficiency of dwellings owned or occupied by income-eligible Ohioans, reduce participants' household energy expenditures and improve participants health and safety.**Eligibility:** Any individual, homeowner or renter with an income at or below 200% of the federal poverty guidelines. HWAP providers give priority to people over the age of 60, those with disabilities, those with children in the home and those with a high energy usage and/or burden.**Eligible Repairs:** Safety inspection, tune-up/repair and if necessary, installation of heating units; insulation of attics, sidewalls, heating ducts, floors, water tanks; reduction of air leakage from major sources; personalized energy management plans.**Type of Funding:** Grant of direct service.**Contact:** 330-643-2537**Program Link:** <https://co.summitoh.net/pages/HWAP.html>**Lead Repairs Allowed?** No**Name of Program:** Lead Abatement Program**Agency:** Summit County, Department of Community & Economic Development**Description:** The County of Summit partners with the Summit County Public Health District to administer the Lead Based Paint Hazard Reduction Program. The program is designed to reduce lead based paint hazards in homes built prior to 1978 with children under the age of 6 residing in the home or visiting the home more than 60 hours a year. Owner occupied housing and rental units are eligible for assistance throughout Summit County.**Eligibility:** To qualify applicants must meet the income guidelines, have current homeowners insurance and be current on their property taxes. Rental units must be registered with the Summit County Fiscal Office and the community where the property is located, if applicable. Assistance is available through a 5 year, deferred, forgivable mortgage. **Description:** Summit County receives funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development under the CDBG and HOME programs to provide a number of housing-oriented programs for low-to-moderate income individuals living within Summit County, but outside the Cities of Akron, Barberton or Cuyahoga Falls. Rental properties and mobile homes are not eligible for assistance.

**Eligibility:** Applicants must meet the current income guidelines, have current homeowners insurance and be current on their property taxes.

**Eligible Repairs:** Assistance may include, health and safety repairs, roof replacement and energy efficiency repairs.

**Type of Funding:** Qualified applicants will receive assistance through a 5 year, deferred, forgivable loan.

**Name of Program:** **Very Low Income Housing Repair Program**

**Agency:** USDA Rural Development

**Description:** Provides loans and grants to very low-income homeowners to repair, improve, or modernize their home.

**Eligibility: Loans** Homeowner must be unable to obtain affordable credit elsewhere and have very low incomes, defined as below 50 percent of the area median income. Maximum loan is \$20,000.

**Eligibility: Grants** Homeowners who are 62 years old or older and cannot repay a Section 504 Loan. Maximum grant is \$7,500.

**Eligible Repairs:** Loans may be used to repair, improve or modernize homes or remove health and safety hazards. Grants must be used to remove health and safety hazards.

**Eligibility:** Eligible households include those with a child under the age of 6 living in the home (or frequently visiting), which are at 80% of the median household income (earn no more than \$52,100.00 for a family of 3) and live in a home built before 1978 which contains lead based paint. Both owner occupied households, and rental structures of 1-4 units are

**Eligible Repairs:** Types of assistance may include new siding, doors, windows, porch repairs, and other improvements which address lead based paint.
