Eligibility: Any individual, homeowner or renter with an income at or below 200% of the federal

poverty guidelines. HWAP providers give priority to people over the age of 60, those with disabilities, those with children in the home and those with a high energy usage and/or Safety inspection, tune-up/repair and if necessary, installation of heating units; insulation

of attics, sidewalls, heating ducts, floors, water tanks; reduction of air leakage from major

sources; personalized energy management plans
