Disclaimer for Lead Safe Housing

The properties on NSP and Lead Safe Housing lists have undergone lead hazard remediation. These properties were assessed for lead hazards and were corrected on the date listed. If the date is not provided on the list and you need to know this information, contact the lead poisoning prevention program for the <u>local or state health department</u>.

These properties met the applicable State of Ohio standard for clearance and received a Certificate of Post-Abatement Clearance on the date listed (if a date is not listed, you can request this information from the local health department or appropriate government agency). Please note the current status of these properties has not been determined.

A Certificate of Post-Abatement Clearance only represents a period of time, and does not guarantee that the housing unit will continue to be lead-safe. For example, if the enclosure of a leaded component is breached which now exposes the leaded component, or a water leak which disturbs a component that was previously intact, lead hazards can result. Occupants of housing that has been remediated for lead hazards have the responsibility of maintaining leaded components to keep the housing unit lead-safe.

Please note that lead safe housing lists are updated periodically and may not be current at a specific point in time.
