Reminder of What Changed in 2024

- WanaBana Applesauce aftermath continued into January
- EPA's Integrated Science Assessment for Lead released in January
- EPA's Soil Screening Level Guidance released in January
- HUD awards historic \$395 Million to control hazards
- EPA's 2020 revisions to Lead and Copper Rule goes into effect in October
- EPA's 2024 improvements to Lead and Copper Rule issued in October
- EPA's Dust-Lead Standards Rule issued in October
- EPA bases actions on quantifying benefits for ADHD, low birthweight and premature cardiovascular (CVD) deaths
- Baby food companies publicly disclose lead test results in January
- FDA issued Action Levels for Lead in Baby Food in January


