Name of Program: Home Weatherization Assistance Program (HWAP)

Agency: Clinton County Community Action Program

Description: No-cost energy assistance program designed to increase the energy efficiency of dwellings

owned or occupied by income-eligible Ohioans, reduce participants' household energy

expenditures and improve participants health and safety.

Eligibility: Any individual, homeowner or renter with an income at or below 200% of the federal

poverty guidelines. HWAP providers give priority to people over the age of 60, those with disabilities, those with children in the home and those with a high energy usage and/or

burden.

Eligible Repairs: Safety inspection, tune-up/repair and if necessary, installation of heating units; insulation

of attics, sidewalls, heating ducts, floors, water tanks; reduction of air leakage from major

sources; personalized energy management plans

Type of Funding: Grant of direct service. No cash benefits.

Name of Program: Lead Hazard Control Grant

Agency: Ohio Department of Health through a grant from HUD

Description: Lead hazard control program for homeowner and tenant households. Households must

have low-to-moderate incomes and lead in their unit. Program assists homeowners directly;

tenants assisted by grant to landlord.

Eligibility: Household income cannot exceed 80% of area median income. If the property is owner-

occupied, either a child under 6 years of age must live in the home or visit a significant

amount of time, or there must be a pregnant woman living in the home.

Structures with more than 4 units not eligible for assistance.

Eligible Repairs: Lead hazard control repairs

Type of Funding: Grant, up to an average of \$8,000 per unit

Name of Program: Very Low Income Housing Repair Program

Agency: USDA Rural Development

Description: Provides loans and grants to very low-income homeowners to repair, improve, or modernize

their home.

Eligibility: Loans Homeowner must be unable to obtain affordable credit elsewhere and have very low

incomes, defined as below 50 percent of the area median income. Maximum loan is

\$20,000.

Eligibility: Grants Homeowners who are 62 years old or older and cannot repay a Section 504 Loan.

Maximum grant is \$7,500.

Eligible Repairs: Loans may be used to repair, improve or modernize homes or remove health and safety

hazards. Grants must be used to remove health and safety hazards.

Description: Emergency Repair Installment Loan: 0-interest loan for homeowners to correct a serious

health/safety or energy conservation condition.

Eligibility: Homeowner occupant in City of Springfield with an emergency condition

Eligible Repairs: Eligible types of repairs include roofing (seasonal), electrical, heating, plumbing, ADA

improvements, and other structural repairs.

Type of Funding: Participants in the Emergency Repair Installment Loan Program receive funding at zero

percent interest. The program can be used once per year. Payments are based on the

amount of funding provided.

Agency: City of Springfield

Description: Under the terms of the HOME Installment Loan, applicants will receive a zero interest loan.

Repayment terms are based on age, affordability, disability, and veteran's status. Applicants may receive up to \$3,500 in the form of a 3 year deferred loan to assist with

costs associated with addressing lead base paint hazards in the home.

Eligibility: Applicants to the program cannot exceed 80% of the Area Median Income for the City of

Springfield, adjusted for family size.

Eligible Repairs: Comprehensive housing rehabilitation. For Home Loan, home must meet all city codes.

Type of Funding: Under the terms of the HOME Installment Loan, applicants will receive a zero interest loan.

Repayment terms are based on age, affordability, disability, and veteran's status.

Applicants may receive up to \$3,500 in the form of a 3 year deferred loan to assist with

costs associated with addressing lead base paint hazards in the home.
